

MRI scanner stops traffic in Gregory Hills

SYDNEY 17 August 2018: There was a very special delivery in Gregory Hills on Friday as a 4.5 tonne MRI scanner was lifted into position at the I-MED Radiology clinic located within the SOMA Health Hub.

Following weeks of planning, the delicate operation included the closing of a road and the removal of an outside wall - to ensure the safe delivery of Gregory Hills' first MRI scanner.

The new I-MED Radiology clinic in Gregory Hills is scheduled to open next month and will offer local residents a full suite of diagnostic imaging services including CT, MRI, ultrasound, general x-ray and interventional procedures. Expert clinical guidance will be provided by a strong doctor group led by Dr Greg Markson, Dr Mark Waterland and Dr Andrew Robinson.

Diana Graham, Regional Manager I-MED Radiology, said the team were excited to see the delivery of the Siemens Magnetom Sempra MRI scanner.
