Medicare Rebates are available for a small number of cardiac MRI studies for specific pathologies or suspected diagnosis. Medicare requirements for accessing these rebates are very specific and can only be claimed when certain clinical conditions are present.

To assist your understanding of the Medicare Rebate criteria we have summarised the data and provided the specific Medicare Rebate Conditions.
