What Is A Platen

The platen is the plate on your heat press

- Typically, top is the one that heats up
 - Exceptions are the 360 IQ Cap (both)
 - Power Platen
- Bottom presses the shirt against the top with pressure needed for application
- Example- Cricut Easy Press does not come with a bottom platen so there is no pressure making it more like an iron with just one platen
- Flat on shirt presses
- Curved on cap presses
- Made of metal with a rubber pad



Interchangeable Platens


Key to application is hard, even surface Avoid seams, pockets, buttons and zippers

Platen that fits allows for easier threadability so working on only the pressing layer





Interchangeable Platens







4 x 4 Works on all shirt presses except A2Z and Craft Press

Uses:

- shirt tags
- youth left chest
- bags
- back yokes
- short sleeve
- short legs



Tip: No quick slip cover available





6 x 10 Available on all heat presses except Craft Press

Uses:

- onsies
- infant
- bags
- left chest
- youth hoodies






8 x 10 Available for all heat presses except A2Z and Craft Press


Uses:

- youth apparel
- cinch sack
- bags










11 x 15 Available for all heat presses except A2Z and Craft Press

Uses:

- women's apparel
- bags
- youth uniforms

Can be turned portrait or landscape



Uses:

- end of roll bags
- stuffed animals
- top of hat







7" Round Available for all heat presses except A2Z and Craft Press





6 x 15 Shoe Available for all heat presses except A2Z and Craft Press







Hat Bill
Available for all heat presses
except 11"x15" Clamshell models,
A2Z and Craft Press







Can Cooler Available on all 16"x20" heat presses







Leg/Sleeve Available on Fusion family of presses only (Fusion, Air Fusion, Dual Air Fusion)








Double Leg/Sleeve Available on all 16"x20" presses



Quick Release Lever







Lift Off



Place on, and close lever




Interchangeable Cap Platens



Sizes

- 2.75 x 6.5
- 3 x 5.75
- 4 x 6.5
- 4 x 8

In A Pinch Tip








Power Platens



- Generates heat from the bottom to prevent scorching
- Sizes
 - 16 x 20
 - 11 x 15
 - 6 x 20
 - 6 x 6
- Controller sold separately
- Compatible with 16 x 20 Auto Clam,
 Maxx Clam and Air Fusion
 *6 x 20 not recommended for Auto Clam
- Transfer Express product use only AquaTru and UltraColor



Platen Covers



- Help keep your platen clean
- Makes it easier to dress or thread your apparel
- Use only on the bottom
- Top covers block the heat causing your transfer to be under-applied



Platen Cleaning Tips

- Hotronix® platens have coating to make clean up easier
- With press warm, wipe with clean dry cloth
- GoJo or other iron cleaners
