

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

### Legal documentation must be received with all name change requests.

- (1) Section I of the form must be filled out using your current legal name and current address.
- (2) Section 2 of the form must be filled out and dated.
- (3) **Proof of name change is required.** Provide photocopies of one or more of the following acceptable documents:
  - (a) A marriage certificate that can be obtained through the county or state in which the marriage took place.
    - (i) The date of the marriage and the signature of the person who performed the ceremony should be included on the document.
    - (ii) Your name on the marriage certificate must match the current name on record with ARRT. If it doesn't match, ARRT will also need legal documentation showing how your name changed from what appears on ARRT records to the name on the marriage certificate.
  - (b) A divorce decree, dissolution of marriage, or divorce certificate.
    - (i) The documents must contain: (1) your current name on record with ARRT, (2) a section stating the resumption of a former/maiden name, and (3) a judge's signature **or** a filed stamp from the clerk of court.
    - (ii) \*\*If the documents do not stipulate a name change, you must also provide **two** of the following that show your current legal name: a photocopy of a signed Social Security card, a valid driver's license, and/or a passport.
  - (c) A court order showing a legal name change. The documents must contain your name before the change went into effect, a section stating what the name was changed to and a signature of a court official.
  - (d) A birth certificate or passport. This is only used for individuals who are changing their abbreviated first name (e.g., Kathy to Katherine), adding a middle name shown on the birth certificate or proving the correct spelling of a name.
  - (e) A Petition for Name Change and Certificate of Naturalization.
    - (i) The Petition for Name Change alone is **not** a stand-alone document. It must be accompanied by the Certificate of Naturalization.
    - (ii) The Certificate of Naturalization must be signed with your new name.
- (4) Any documentation that is not in English must be accompanied by a signed translation document.
- (5) If submitting by mail, send photocopies of your documentation. Documents will not be returned.
- (6) Allow 7-10 business days for processing. Contact the Continuing Registration Department at 651.687.0048 after the process period if you would like to confirm your name change with ARRT.
