Top 25 Major Comorbidities & Complications (MCC)

1. Rupture of chordae tendineae, not elsewhere classified
2. Acute respiratory failure with hypoxia
3. Cardiogenic shock
4. Acute pulmonary insufficiency following thoracic surgery
5. Acute on chronic diastolic (congestive) heart failure
6. Acute on chronic systolic (congestive) heart failure
7. Acute kidney failure with tubular necrosis
8. Acute on chronic combined systolic and diastolic heart failure
9. Acute systolic (congestive) heart failure
10. Other shock
11. Pneumonia, unspecified organism
12. End stage renal disease
13. Acute postprocedural respiratory failure
14. Acute pulmonary edema
15. Acute diastolic (congestive) heart failure
16. Acute and subacute hepatic failure without coma
17. Acute and subacute infective endocarditis
18. Acute respiratory failure with hypercapnia
19. Metabolic encephalopathy
20. Unspecified severe protein-calorie malnutrition
21. Sepsis, unspecified organism
22. Ventricular fibrillation
23. Severe sepsis with septic shock
24. Acute respiratory failure, unspecified with hypoxia or hypercapnia
25. Hypovolemic shock

Top Comorbidities & Complications (CC)

1. Acute posthemorrhagic anemia
2. Atelectasis
3. Acute kidney failure, unspecified
4. Acidosis, unspecified
5. Hypo-osmolality and hyponatremia
6. Chronic diastolic (congestive) heart failure
7. Unspecified atrial flutter
8. Hypertensive heart and chronic kidney disease with heart failure and stage 1 through stage 4 chronic kidney disease, or unspecified chronic kidney disease
9. Pleural effusion, not elsewhere classified
10. Coagulation defect, unspecified
11. Patent foramen ovale
12. Other persistent atrial fibrillation
13. Ventricular tachycardia, unspecified
14. Other postprocedural cardiac functional disturbances following cardiac surgery
15. Atrioventricular block, complete
16. Chronic systolic (congestive) heart failure
17. Other cardiomyopathies
18. Chronic atrial fibrillation, unspecified
19. Hyperosmolality and hypernatremia
20. Delirium due to known physiological condition
21. Urinary tract infection, site not specified
22. Pneumothorax, unspecified
23. Other pericardial effusion (noninflammatory)
24. Permanent atrial fibrillation
25. Chronic combined systolic and diastolic heart failure
