Top 25 Major Comorbidities & Complications (MCC)

1. Acute respiratory failure with hypoxia
2. Cardiogenic shock
3. Acute on chronic diastolic (congestive) heart failure
4. Acute kidney failure with tubular necrosis
5. Acute on chronic combined systolic and diastolic heart failure
6. Acute on chronic systolic (congestive) heart failure
7. Acute pulmonary insufficiency following thoracic surgery
8. End stage renal disease
9. Acute and subacute infective endocarditis
10. Pneumonia, unspecified organism
11. Metabolic encephalopathy
12. Unspecified severe protein-calorie malnutrition
13. Rupture of chordae tendineae, not elsewhere classified
14. Severe sepsis with septic shock
15. Acute and subacute hepatic failure without coma
16. Other shock
17. Acute respiratory failure with hypercapnia
18. Acute postprocedural respiratory failure
19. Sepsis, unspecified organism
20. Acute systolic (congestive) heart failure
21. Other toxic encephalopathy
22. Acute and chronic respiratory failure with hypoxia
23. Pneumonitis due to inhalation of food and vomit
24. Acute pulmonary edema
25. Acute diastolic (congestive) heart failure

Top Comorbidities & Complications (CC)

1. Acute posthemorrhagic anemia
2. Acute kidney failure, unspecified
3. Atelectasis
4. Hypo-osmolality and hyponatremia
5. Hypertensive heart and chronic kidney disease with heart failure and stage 1 through stage 4 chronic kidney disease, or unspecified chronic kidney disease
6. Acidosis, unspecified
7. Unspecified atrial flutter
8. Atrioventricular block, complete
9. Coagulation defect, unspecified
10. Chronic diastolic (congestive) heart failure
11. Pleural effusion, not elsewhere classified
12. Other persistent atrial fibrillation
13. Ventricular tachycardia, unspecified
14. Hyperosmolality and hypernatremia
15. Urinary tract infection, site not specified
16. Delirium due to known physiological condition
17. Patent foramen ovale
18. Other cardiomyopathies
19. Chronic atrial fibrillation, unspecified
20. Chronic systolic (congestive) heart failure
21. Other postprocedural cardiac functional disturbances following cardiac surgery
22. Permanent atrial fibrillation
23. Hypertensive heart and chronic kidney disease with heart failure and with stage 5 chronic kidney disease, or end stage renal disease
24. Other pericardial effusion (noninflammatory)
25. Alkalosis
