
MECHTILD HARF RESEARCH GRANTS

FOR THE STUDY OF HEMATOPOIETIC STEM CELL TRANSPLANTATION AND CELL THERAPIES OF HEMATOLOGIC MALIGNANCIES



In honor of Mechtild Harf, DKMS provides two annual grants to promising and developing researchers to advance the understanding of therapeutic strategies in the context of hematopoietic cell transplantation and cellular therapies for hematologic malignancies.

RESEARCH SCOPE

Proposals must address issues of hematopoietic transplantation and/or cell therapies for hematologic malignancies, from cellular to pre-clinical animal models to human studies including co-funded clinical trials.

DESCRIPTION

The Mechtild Harf Research Program provides two annual grants up to a maximum of € 240,000, payable over a 3 year period (maximum € 80.000 annually). Each funding

year runs from July 1st to June 30th. Two projects will be selected from the eligible applications.

QUALIFICATIONS OF RESEARCHERS

Applicants must have a doctoral degree (M.D., Ph.D., or equivalent) in a field pertinent to the award within the past twelve years. Applicants do not have to hold a faculty position and can be in training (Fellows, Postdoctoral Fellows and Junior Faculty). Applicants from all countries are invited to submit an application.
