MI Downing UK Micro-Cap Growth Fund

About the Fund

MI Downing UK Micro-Cap Growth Fund ("the Fund") aims to invest in a concentrated portfolio of between 25-30 UK companies within the Numis Smaller Companies Indices - typically those with market capitalisations between £20 million and £150 million.

The Fund seeks to generate capital growth, whilst retaining a strong focus on capital preservation. The Fund aims to outperform returns from other UK small-cap equity funds by selecting investments that the Manager believes are undervalued by the market.

Portfolio commentary

In April, the Fund was up 2.49%, underperforming the benchmark, which was up 4.13%. Positive contributors included FireAngel Safety Technology (up 73.81%) and Gama Aviation (up 50.39%). Detractors included Redhall Group (down 41.67%) and Synectics (down 11.30%).


FireAngel has restructured its banking facilities alongside a placing and open offer which raised £6.0 million. This will provide working capital, improve the balance sheet and create stability for the business. We believe that the market responded positively to the raise and took comfort in the level of the company directors' participation.

Gama announced final results for FY2018 in accordance with its improved reporting methodology. It also announced a number of management changes, with Simon To appointed chairman and Christopher Clarke and Michael Howell appointed Non-Executive Directors. We believe the share price was supported by Hutchison purchasing stock.

Redhall reported no material news in April. However, a trading statement issued on 1 May warned that anticipated full year trading performance will be materially below previous expectations. Final results are dependent upon securing a number of key prospects and therefore remain uncertain. Market conditions remain robust in the group's core markets and its pipeline of opportunities remains strong. The board anticipates that this will deliver steady growth into 2020.

Synectics reported that it has experienced order deferrals and delays in the progress of existing contracts, which are believed to be in part due to Brexit uncertainties. The impact is that profits will be substantially more weighted to the second half of this financial year than originally budgeted. Although management still anticipates that results for the full year will be in line with expectations, the second half weighting has inevitably increased delivery timing risks.

Cumulative performance under Downing management




