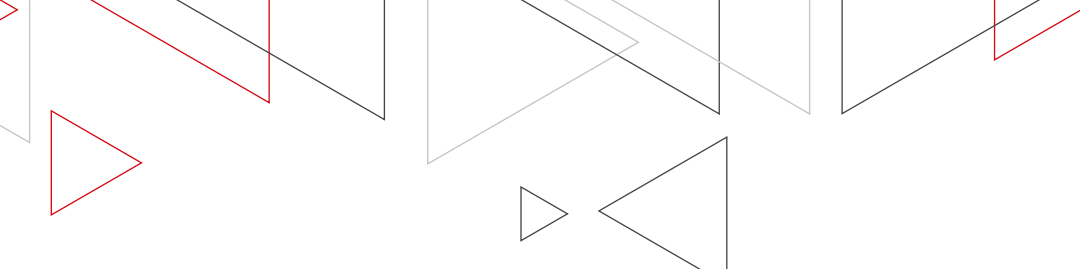

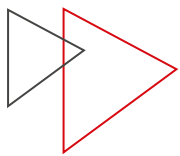

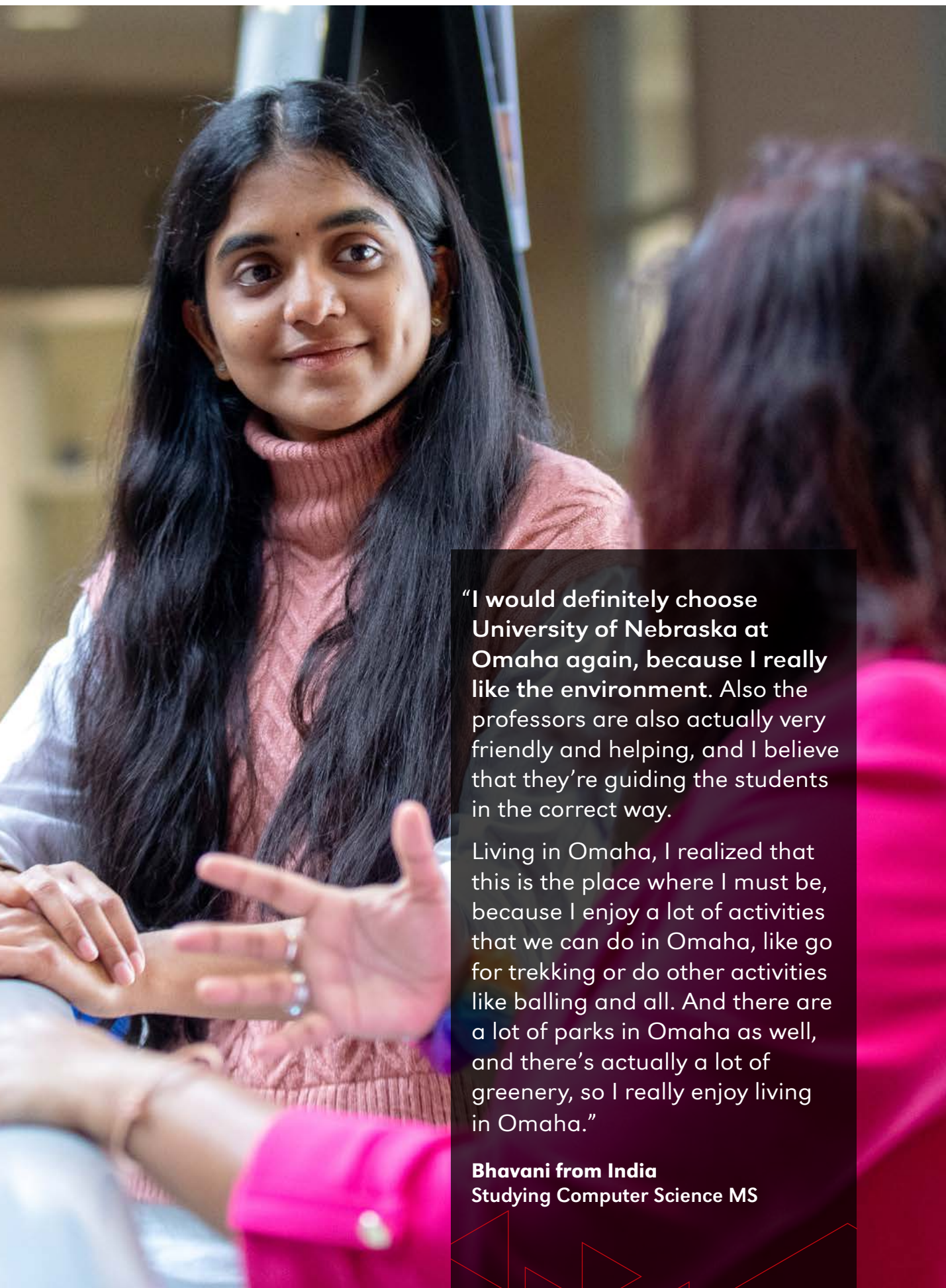

HIGHLIGHTED DEGREE PROGRAMS

UNO offers many STEM-designated degrees at the undergraduate and graduate levels. Completing one of these programs may qualify international students to extend their post-graduation stay in the USA through Optional Practical Training (OPT) STEM Extension.

After finishing a program of study and initial post-completion OPT, eligible F-1 students may apply for a STEM-OPT extension for a 24-month period. Refer to www.ice.gov/sevis for more information.

International students should talk with their UNO advisors to confirm that their chosen program is a STEM-designated degree.

Business Administration, BS, MBA

UNO's Business programs provide diverse concentration options, including Business Analytics, Accounting, Marketing, and Supply Chain Management. With a focus on innovative, career-oriented learning, transformative research, industry collaboration, and community engagement, you'll be equipped to excel in the field that inspires you the most.

Cybersecurity, BS*, MS*

Cybersecurity is a critical field that stands at the forefront of protecting our increasingly digital society. Our programs equip students with the essential skills to design, develop, manage, and secure information systems. The modern world is made up of vast data exchanges and internet-connected systems with many kinds of private and confidential information on them. Our students learn to think like an adversary to ethically hack systems to identify and mitigate vulnerabilities.

Data Science, MS*

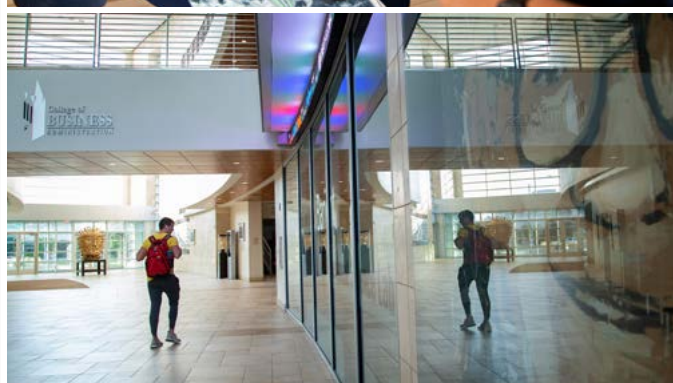

College of Information Science & Technology (IS&T)

- The Peter Kiewit Institute offers up-to-date instruction with faculty and students conducting research in software development, language systems, robotics, data mining, high-performance computing, and other related areas
- Key to the collaborative environment at the College of IS&T is the intellectual linkage between academia, industry, and state government. This linkage has led to a substantial investment of \$70M into infrastructure development that includes:
 - A \$37.5M Information Science Technology & Engineering building on UNO's Scott Campus
 - 24 new faculty positions
 - 100+ student scholarships
 - Endowments for faculty support
 - Substantial laboratory and computing support

NebraskaCYBER

Since its founding in 2001, the Nebraska University Center for Cybersecurity (NebraskaCYBER) has helped improve cybersecurity awareness locally, regionally, and nationally. The collaborative efforts of faculty, students, and community partners have earned UNO the distinction of being named a Center of Academic Excellence by the National Security Agency (NSA).

College of Business Administration: Mammel Hall

- It's a hub of learning and collaboration. It's the place where local businesses gather. And it's where Warren Buffett sent his first tweet.
- Opened in fall 2010, Mammel Hall is home to the College of Business Administration, offering a professional and inviting environment for students, faculty, staff, and visitors. This state-of-the-art, 120,000-square-foot building was made possible by the largest single donation in UNO's history and is specifically designed for business students.

Key features include:

- An atrium with interactive touch-screen displays
- Collaborative breakout rooms and private study areas
- A two-story, 186-seat auditorium
- Student lounge areas and Stedman's Cafe
- Glass-walled classrooms and meeting rooms with advanced technology
- Laboratories for investment science, innovation, entrepreneurship, and executive decision-making
- Mammel Hall is also the first LEED gold-certified academic building in Nebraska, featuring digital signage that conserves resources overnight and rain gardens that capture runoff to remove pollutants and nurture native plants.

BOB KERREY PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE

Spanning the Missouri River, this pedestrian bridge offers stunning views of the city skyline and is a great spot for walking, biking, or just enjoying the scenery.

HENRY DOORLY ZOO AND AQUARIUM
