How to book your accommodation

It's important that you book your accommodation as early as possible to ensure you live within a reasonable distance of the International Study Centre and make the most of your experience at Teesside.

Request your accommodation early

If you request accommodation on your application form, our Central Student Services team will contact you directly regarding the options available.

It's your responsibility to find suitable accommodation within a maximum of a 50-mile radius of Teesside International Study Centre but we are happy to help you find your accommodation at Teesside.

Student accommodation

Living in accommodation with other students is the best way to experience student life in the UK and will help you to settle-in, focus on your studies and make friends more easily.

At Teesside University International Study Centre we offer accommodation at Infinity House and Rialto Court which offer safe and modern accommodation located in Stockton-on-Tees.

Application process

Once a room offer is made, it is important to accept the offer and follow any requested actions within the allotted time, otherwise it will expire. Please submit your application for accommodation as soon as you can, and the team will process it as quickly as possible.

Private accommodation

If you plan to book your own accommodation, please remember this needs to be no further than 50 miles from the International Study Centre (TS1 3BX). Middlesbrough is the ideal choice because of both its location and lifestyle for students.

As a private renter, you will be signing a legal contract when booking your accommodation and will be held to the clauses in that contract. If you are unsure of anything in the legal document, you will need to seek independent legal advice.

Book early to live nearby





Middlesbrough - Town Centre

Cosmopolitan restaurants, shopping centres, micropubs, sports centres, cinemas, galleries and museums all make Middlesbrough a great place to live.

Darlington

Historic "Darlo" offers arts, culture and sports venues and a twice-weekly market. Darlington is just 40 minutes from the International Study Centre by train.

Redcar

Redcar is the local seaside town 7 miles east of Middlesbrough, offering classic fish and chips, a new vertical pier and beautiful sea views. Redcar is 30 minutes away by train.

Stockton-on-Tees

Stockton is a small market town only a 30-minute train journey away. It is located on the banks of the River Tees, offering peaceful riverside walks and water sports activities.

Saltburn

Another seaside town with a stunning beach and independent shops, Saltburn dates back to the Victorian era which you can see in the local architecture. Saltburn is 35 minutes away by train.

Stokesley

Stokesley is an elegant market town, dotted with Georgian and Victorian buildings. Known as a gateway to the North York Moors, there are lots of independent local shops, restaurants and takeaways to cater to your needs. It is 1 hour away by train.

The International Study Centre has partnered with UniKitOut so you can buy starter packs for your bedroom, kitchen and bathroom before you arrive.


