What will happen during induction week?

Attendance, Engagement & Behaviour: Learn about the ISC attendance policy and receive your timetable.	About Durham University ISC: Get to know the campus and how you can make the most of your time.
Meet your classmates: Meet people who are studying with you and make lifelong friends! Get involved in the activities across the week!	Living in Stockton-on-Tees: Learn all about your new home.
