The International Foundation Year programme **prepares you to enter the first year of your chosen undergraduate degree**. This programme is made up of English language modules, as well as study and academic skills modules.

What you'll learn

The International Foundation Year aims to improve the English, study and academic skills that you will need to succeed in your undergraduate degree, as well as in your future career once you graduate.

Programmes tailored to you

At the International Study Centre we teach three International Foundation Year subject pathways that will prepare you for studying at Leeds Beckett University.

- Business, Law and Social Studies
- Health Sciences*
- Science, Engineering and Computing

INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION YEAR

BUSINESS, LAW AND SOCIAL STUDIES

This pathway leads to a wide range of exciting undergraduate degrees at Leeds Beckett University.

Programme modules

Academic English Skills

Academic English Skills aims to enhance your language abilities and academic skills for university success. It focuses on improving your written and spoken language for effective and confident communication in an academic setting.

Business in a Global Context

This module will introduce you to the global nature of business and to the various political, economic, and cultural issues associated with international business. It will also support you in developing your teamwork, research and communication skills, by employing a practical assessment strategy.

Business and Finance

Develop your understanding of key management, business and finance issues and methodologies used in business practice. The module will be problem orientated, taking realistic business settings and showing you how techniques of financial and data analysis can be used to offer alternative solutions and predict financial consequences.

Law

Learn about the law and legal system in England and Wales, including its underlying principles, the personnel who administer it, the mechanics of the legal process, and justice in broader perspectives.

This module also introduces you to the core principles in Criminal Law, Tort Law, and Contract Law.

Project Skills

You will have an opportunity to identify and research a topic aligned to your progression degree. It will equip you with fundamental scholarly, research and transferable skills, necessary for progression onto an undergraduate course.

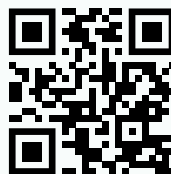
Social Sciences

This module introduces you to three interlinked social sciences: Politics, Criminology, and Sociology. Concepts and case studies are introduced and understood through three interrelated lenses to provide you with a wide-ranging understanding of international issues.

INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION YEAR HEALTH SCIENCES*

This pathway leads to a wide range of exciting undergraduate degrees at Leeds Beckett University.

Programme modules

Academic English Skills

Academic English Skills aims to enhance your language abilities and academic skills for university success. It focuses on improving your written and spoken language for effective and confident communication in an academic setting.

Biology

This module will introduce the fundamental concepts of human biology consisting of seven key topics: cells, biological molecules, movement across membranes, protein synthesis, cell replication, enzymes, and respiration.

This module will develop your knowledge of the major systems of the human body consisting of six key topics: the circulatory, respiratory, digestive, nervous, urinary, and hormonal systems. The module also develops your Maths, laboratory skills and scientific report writing as well as introducing them to experiment planning.

Chemistry

This module will introduce you to the fundamental principles that form the basis of chemistry. It consists of seven key topics: Atomic Structure and Bonding, Mole concept, Redox reactions, Thermodynamics, Chemical Equilibria, Chemical Kinetics, and Organic Chemistry. The module also further develops your laboratory skills and scientific report writing as well as introducing you to experiment planning.

Project Skills

Benefit from an opportunity to identify and research a topic aligned to your progression degree. This module will equip you with fundamental scholarly, research and transferable skills, necessary for progression onto an undergraduate course.

Health and Social Care

This module provides an introduction to the field of adult nursing, equipping you with the knowledge and skills necessary to provide high-quality care for adults, as well as people of all ages, including mental and physical health where it exists.

You will learn the professional, ethical and legal principles that underpin accountable, evidence based professional practice. You will also understand how the professional standards as outlined in the legal and regulatory frameworks in England, impact on professional practice.

You will learn how to deliver safe and effective care to patients, using the skills and knowledge of communication gained in the module.

This pathway leads to a wide range of exciting undergraduate degrees at Leeds Beckett University.

Programme modules Academic English Skills

Academic English Skills aims to enhance your language abilities and academic skills for university success. It focuses on improving your written and spoken language for effective and confident communication in an academic setting.

Biology

Develop your knowledge of the major systems of the human body through an introduction to the fundamental concepts of human biology. This module also further develops your Maths, laboratory skills and scientific report writing as well as introducing you to experiment planning.

Chemistry

This module introduces you to the fundamental principles of Chemistry, enhancing your laboratory skills, scientific report writing, and experiment planning.

Physics

Gain an essential understanding and garner interest in key aspects of Physics (materials, fluids, electrical circuits) in preparation for degree courses in Engineering, Computing and other STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics) subjects.

Project Skills

Benefit from an opportunity to identify and research a topic aligned to your progression degree. This module will equip you with fundamental scholarly, research and transferable skills, necessary for progression onto an undergraduate course.

Maths for Engineering and Computing

Programme modules

Academic English Skills

Computer Programming

Explore the basics of computer programming in this module from the fundamental principles and techniques. You'll build a solid foundation and then move on to object-oriented programming, a key paradigm that will refine your problem-solving and software development skills.

Computer Systems and Fundamentals of Computer Science

Gain a comprehensive understanding of computer systems through this module. It covers essential topics such as operating systems, hardware, data storage, and algorithm design, providing you with a solid grasp of computer science fundamentals.

Computer Communications and Fundamentals of Databases

This module covers the principles of computer communication, flow of data in computer networks and quality of service. It will also introduce you to the concept of databases, a key concept in computer science to store a large amount of data.

Fundamentals of Digital Forensics, Ethical Hacking and Penetration Testing

Develop your knowledge in digital forensics by learning how to acquire digital evidence while adhering to legal and ethical standards. The module also includes training in ethical hacking and penetration testing to evaluate the security of developed applications.

Academic English Skills

Academic English Skills aims to enhance your language abilities and academic skills for university success. It focuses on improving your written and spoken language for effective and confident communication in an academic setting.

Human Physiology and Kinesiology in Sport and Exercise Science

Designed to provide a thorough understanding of sport and exercise physiology, this module equips you with the skills to measure physiological functions accurately. It also covers biomechanics, human anatomy, and the principles behind human movement.

Human Behaviour in Sport and Exercise Science

This module aims to introduce you to the fundamental principles and origins of sport and exercise psychology as a scientific study of human behaviour within sport and exercise contexts. This module introduces you to the core concepts and foundations of sport and exercise psychology, examining human behaviour within the contexts of sport and exercise from a scientific perspective.

Nutrition (for health and sports performance)

Understand the role of food as a source of energy and how the body processes and utilises it. This module explores metabolism and energy utilisation, emphasising the critical role of nutrition in maintaining body functions during both rest and activity.

Carnegie School of Sport

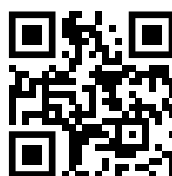
