Postgraduate taught programmes

Study a Master's with the University of Huddersfield - London and tailor your qualification to your own personal and career interests. The interdisciplinary option modules available on our programmes ensure you get the most out of your studies.

Through our management, international business or entrepreneurship Master's you can pursue a number of careers, such as management consultant, sales manager, business development manager, human resource manager, business advisor, account manager, PR manager, recruitment consultant, director, project manager. Or choose a computing Master's and pursue careers in security, web development or information technology.

All students on a Management or Business Master's complete a Final Project. This project offers an opportunity to explore an area of personal interest or passion. You have a choice of three routes: Research Route, Consultancy Route and New Venture Creation Route (subject to tutor approval).

Our intensive pre-course induction workshop, held in September and January, offers an in-depth introduction to your course.
