## What key activities will take place during the Induction programme?

<b>Registration and VISA Compliance</b> Begin your journey by completing the necessary formalities and providing documents to scan to make students legally compliant.	<b>ISC Welcome</b> You will be greeted by Cardiff ISC staff and given an induction pack which includes important information for your enrolment, also receive a warm welcome from the Centre Director, Beth Tudball.
<b>Introduction to UK and Welsh Culture</b> Learn about culture and etiquette in the UK and then more specifically about Welsh Culture. Join this session to take part in a quiz with the opportunity for prizes!	<b>Introduction to Academic English Skills and Personal Tutorials</b> All students will complete an Academic English Skills module and will have a personal tutor. Learn about this from the Head of English.
<b>Progression to Cardiff University</b> Our Senior Progression and Transition Coordinator will give you an overview of progression at Cardiff ISC, including how to review your requirements, read your progress reports and change your degree programme.	<b>Your Health and Wellbeing</b> Meet the Welfare and Enrichment team and find out how we can support you throughout your studies. We will help you to register with a doctor and tell you how to access the NHS and support services in Cardiff.
<b>Under 18s information session</b> Students aged under 18 will need to attend this session to hear about how we will support you during your studies. You will meet the welfare team and your ISC Guardians.	<b>Learning Central Tour and Quiz</b> Students need to look through the relevant modules on Learning Central. Once you have read these fully, including the policies, you need to complete the Induction Quiz by the end of the day. This is mandatory for all students to ensure you have completed your enrolment.
