Taught at Leeds International Study Centre, the International Foundation Year programme prepares you to enter the first year of your chosen undergraduate degree. This programme is made up of English language modules, as well as study and academic skills modules.

What you'll learn

The International Foundation Year aims to improve the English, study and academic skills you will need to succeed in your undergraduate degree, as well as in your future career once you graduate.

Courses tailored to you

At Leeds International Study Centre we teach two International Foundation Year programmes that will prepare you for studying at Leeds Beckett University.

- Business, Law and Social Studies
- Science, Engineering and Computing

Assessment

Your work will be regularly assessed through coursework assignments, presentations, essays, case studies and exams.

International Foundation Year Business, Law and Social Studies



This course leads to a wide range of exciting undergraduate degrees at Leeds Beckett University, in areas ranging from business and law to marketing and public relations.

Modules:

Academic English Skills

Academic English Skills aims to provide thorough training in the language and related academic skills which will enable international students to best achieve their academic potential at university. Our Academic English Skills module is validated by UK ENIC, the UK government agency responsible for providing information and expert opinion on qualifications and skills worldwide.

You will develop awareness and competency in a range of language-related academic skills, including the processes of academic writing, effective and extensive reading strategies, effective participation in seminars and delivery of presentations, and listening to and recording information effectively from lectures. You will also develop the accuracy and range of written and spoken language required to use language effectively and appropriately, with clarity and confidence in an academic context.

Alongside your classes, your studies will be supported by an online learning platform, providing you with a range of tasks and activities specifically designed to develop and extend your language and academic skills outside the classroom and to give you more control over your own learning.

Business in a Global Context

This module will introduce you to the global nature of business and to the various political, economic, and cultural issues associated with international business. It will also support you in developing your teamwork, research and communication skills, and give you an introduction to the local economy, by employing a practical, case-based assessment strategy.

Business and Finance

This module will develop your understanding of key management business and finance issues and methodologies used in business practice to aid and inform decision making and performance management. The module will be problem-solving orientated, taking realistic business settings and showing how techniques of financial and data analysis can be used to offer alternative solutions and predict financial consequences.

Project Skills

This module provides you with an opportunity to identify and research a topic aligned to your progression degree. It will equip you with fundamental scholarly, research and transferable skills necessary for progression on to an undergraduate course.

Social Sciences

This module introduces you to three interlinked social sciences: politics, criminology and sociology. Concepts and case studies are introduced and understood through three interrelated lenses to provide you with a wide-ranging understanding of international issues.

Law

This module introduces you to the law and legal system in England and Wales, including its underlying principles, the personnel who administer it, the mechanics of the legal process, and justice in broader perspectives. It also introduces you to the core principles in Criminal Law, Tort Law and Contract Law.

International Foundation Year Science, Engineering and Computing



This course leads to a wide range of exciting undergraduate degrees at Leeds Beckett University, in areas ranging from biomedical sciences and civil engineering to computing.

Modules:

Academic English Skills

Academic English Skills aims to provide thorough training in the language and related academic skills which will enable international students to best achieve their academic potential at university. Our Academic English Skills module is validated by UK ENIC, the UK government agency responsible for providing information and expert opinion on qualifications and skills worldwide.

You will develop awareness and competency in a range of language-related academic skills, including the processes of academic writing, effective and extensive reading strategies, effective participation in seminars, delivery of presentations, and listening to and recording information effectively from lectures. You will also develop the accuracy and range of written and spoken language required to use language effectively and appropriately, with clarity and confidence in an academic context.

Alongside your classes, your studies will be supported by an online learning platform, providing you with a range of tasks and activities specifically designed to develop and extend your language and academic skills outside the classroom and to give you more control over your own learning.

Biology

This module will introduce you to the fundamental concepts of human biology consisting of seven key topics: cells, biological molecules, movement across membranes, protein synthesis, cell replication, enzymes, and respiration. This module will further develop your knowledge of the major systems of the human body consisting of six key topics: the circulatory, respiratory, digestive, nervous, urinary, and hormonal systems. The module also further develops your maths, laboratory skills and scientific report writing as well as introducing you to experiment planning.

Chemistry

This module introduces you to the fundamental principles that form the basis of chemistry. It consists of seven key topics: Atomic Structure and Bonding, Mole concept, Redox reactions, Thermodynamics, Chemical Equilibria, Chemical Kinetics, and Organic Chemistry. The module also further develops your laboratory skills and scientific report writing as well as introduces you to experiment planning.

Physics

This physics module provides you with an essential understanding of physics (materials, fluids, electrical circuits) in preparation for degree courses in engineering, computing and other STEM subjects. It provides opportunities for you to master your English language skills through discussion and academic writing.

Maths for Engineering and Computing

Mathematics for Engineering and Computing provides you with a foundation in the mathematical modelling of systems and the core maths skills which are integral to courses in engineering, computing and other STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) subjects. It aims to garner interest in mathematics as a subject and through exposure to its applications. It also aims to develop self-confidence so that you are ready to take initiative and work independently.
