



BASIC OPERATION

TURN PLAYER ON/OFF

Press \circlearrowleft SRC button to turn the player on. When system is on press and hold \circlearrowleft SRC button to turn the player off.

MENU SETTING

Please set the Radio AREA /REGION to EUR

Repeatedly press **MENU** button for audio menu: BASS-TRE (Treble) -BAL(Balance)-ART(on/off)-EQ(flat/pop/rock/clas/off)-XBASS(on/off)-BEEP(on/off)-DX(Loc)-STEREO(MONO)-CLOCK(12/24)-

AREA(EUR/USA/LAT).

In each item rotate the VOL knob to set them.

LOC ON/OFF

LOC ON: To reduce the receiving sensitivity when you search stations, which means you can receive the stations that sound clear.

LOC OFF: Don't reduce receiving sensitivity when you search stations, which means you can receive more stations.

STEREO/MONO

STEREO: Receiving FM stereo signal.

MONO: Change to monochrome when the signal is not strong as this will reduce noise.

TA VOL

To define the minimum volume of traffic announcements. If the main volume is under the TA volume. When a traffic announcement station was received the main volume will be raised up to the TA volume automatically.

CLOCK SETTING

(1) MANUAL SETTING: Press and hold DISP button for 2 seconds. The hour of the time display will be flashing. Press ▶1/ ► button (or rotating the audio knobs) to set the hour. Press DISP button shortly to change to minutes. Also use the ▶1/ ► button (or rotating the audio knob) to set the correct minutes. Then press DISP to confirm your selection.

CLOCK SETTING

(2) MANUAL SETTING: Switching on the AF function and received a RDS station which has a good signal (The AF symbol of the LCD does not flash). Several minutes later the time will be synchronised to the correct time according to the station's signal. (NOTE: None RDS station does not have this function).

AUX FUNCTION

The player has 2pcs of 3.5mm jack. It can be connected to a portable audio player through the **AUX IN** jack. Pressing **SRC** button to switch to **F-AUX/R AUX** mode when inserted and audio source to the player.

RESET FUNCTION

The **RESET** button is to be activated for the following reasons:

(1) All the function buttons do not operate.

(2) Error symbol on the display.

NOTE: When **RESET** button is pressed all the memory will be lost.

RADIO OPERATION

RECEIVE A RADIO STATION

Press **SCR** button to select radio mode. Then press **BAND** button to select a band. Shortly press **▶** | / | button to receive the desired radio station. Press and hold **▶** | / | button to manually tune the frequency.

AUTO STORE STATIONS

Press **TS** button for 2 seconds to auto store stations to numeric buttons 1–6 of band 3.

PRESET SCAN STATIONS

Shortly press **TS** button to scan the preset stations stored in numeric buttons 1–6 of hand 1–3

MANUALLY STORE STATION & RECALL PRESET STATION

To tune a station, press one of the preset buttons 1–6 for 2 seconds. The current station is stored into the number button. Shortly press the preset button 1–6 to directly listen to the station saved in the corresponding preset button.

RDS (RADIO DATA SYSTEM) OPERATION

ALTERNATIVE FREQUENCY (AF) Press AF button to switch on/off AF function.

AF ON Symbol AF appears on the display. Program name is displayed on

receiving a **RDS** station. **AF** symbol starts blinking if the broadcasting signal gets worse. It will start to search the stronger station in **AF** list and switch to that station. If no stronger station is found in **AF** list it will activate the **PI SEEK** mode to search stations which as

same PI.

ALARM will be displayed when an emergency broadcasting is

received, meanwhile sound output level will be adjusted to the preset output level automatically when the volume control is set

at minimum.

AF OFF switch off the AF mode.

REG ON the current listening program remains unchanged.

REG OFF it allows the reception to move to the regional station.

TRAFFIC ANNOUNCEMENT (TA) Press teh TA button to turn TA function on/off.

TA ON When received a TA station it will switch temporarily to radio mode

to listen to the TA station whatever RADIO/USB/SD/AUX/BT mode.
If the volume level was under the TA volume it will be raised to the

TA volume automatically.

TA OFF Turn TA function off.

USB/SD OPERATION

When a **usb** drive/**TF** card is inserted the unit will play the MP3/WMA file automatically. If a **usb/TF** drive is already inserted into the unit keep pressing the **src** button shortly until the **usb/sp** mode display appears.

SELECT FILE Press ▶ I/ ★ button to select the following/previous file. Hold

button to fast forward or fast reverse.

PLAY/PAUSE FUNCTION

Press ▶ button to pause playing. Press it again to resume play.

SCAN FUNCTION

Press \mathbf{SCN} button to turn on/off the \mathbf{SCAN} function.

SCN ON: playing first 10 seconds of each file.

SCN OFF: cancel **SCAN** funtion.

REPEAT FUNCTION

Press RPT button to select one of the following repeats:

REPEAT FOLDER: repeat all the files in the folder.

REPEAT ONE: always repeat the same file.

REPEAT ALL: repeat all files (default).

RANDOM FUNCTION

Press **RDM** button to turn on/off the random function:

RDM ON: to play all the files in random order.

RDM OFF: cancel random function.

DIRECTORY UP/DOWN

Press **DIR-/DIR+** button to select previous directory or next directory.

+10/-10 FILE FUNCTION

Press and hold button **DIR-/DIR+** for **+10/-10** function.

FILE SEARCH

There are two ways to search for songs: **DIR** and **NUM** search.

Press button to select these.

(1) DIR SEARCH: Press button once. It will show DIR SCH. Rotating the VOL knob to select the folder then press VOL know into the folder. Rotating the VOL knob again to select the file. Then press VOL to confirm. The unit searches the selected song to play.

(2) NUM SEARCH: Press → button twice. It will show NUM SCH. You can select the file by directly entering numeric buttons 0-9 (EQ=7, I = 8, I = 9). You also can rotate the VOL knob to select the numbers. When file number has been selected, press the VOL knob for seconds. The unit then searches the files after a few seconds even if the VOL knob is not pressed.

NOTE: When connecting an MP3 player which has a non

rechargeable battery, you should remove that battery from the MP3 player prior to connecting via the USB interface. Otherwise it may

cause the battery to burst.

CAUTION When there are important files on the USB drive/TF card, do not

connect it to the main unit to play as any wrong operation may cause file loss. We cannot accept responsibility for the saftey of

your files.

BLUETOOTH OPERATION

PAIRING On mobile phone, select the bluetooth item and search for

bluetooth device. 'Sunlighten' should appear in the list, select 'Sunlighten' and then input password '0000' if a password is required. When successcfully paired the BT mark will be displayed

on LCD.

BLUETOOTH AUDIO Press SRC button to switch to BT mode. It will play a song from your

mobile device automatically. Press ▶ to pause/play the song. Press

▶ | / | button to select next/previous song.
