

President's Message



The term *glocal* was coined in the 2009 movie, *Up in the Air*, to advance the technology-driven notion that everything that is local is also global, and vice versa. Within the film's context this idea misfires, but for libraries seeking to provide information to anyone regardless of location, *glocal* is a useful concept.

The Linda Hall Library provides "Information for the World," and a look back at the Library's 2012 achievements illustrates its global impact. Whether supplying digital copies of technical reports and scientific papers to the 262 member libraries of the Center for Research Libraries; hosting resident scholars from Korea, Germany, Italy, and the U.S.; or uploading lecture videos that were viewed in 104 countries on six continents, the Linda Hall Library has extended its international reach while significantly enriching Kansas City's cultural climate through exhibitions, lectures, and the availability of its more than one million volumes to anyone wishing to use them.






