# A reflection...

Today we enter the season of Advent. It is a time of preparation, expectation, and prayerful reflection on the central mystery of our faith, that God has become one of us in Jesus. As we prepare once again to welcome Jesus into our hearts, we remind ourselves that He is already with us, and so at Christmas we celebrate his presence and strengthen the welcome that we offer to Him each day of our lives.

In today's Gospel St Mark tells us that Jesus exhorted His disciples to "stay awake" since they would not know when the time would come. Marks's community believed that Jesus would soon return to earth to gather up God's people, all of creation, and lead us home to God (the Parousia). The reality is that we have no idea when this might happen, but we have opportunities each day to allow Jesus to lead us closer to God. Through times of prayer, reflection, and silence, we remain alert (stay awake) to the presence of Jesus in the ordinariness of our daily lives, and the extraordinariness of God's many gifts.

Let us (me!) not be distracted too much by the twinkling Christmas lights, the shopping frenzy, the Christmas rush, holiday preparations and a variety of festive activities. Come, Lord Jesus, Come.
