A reflection...

When I was growing up in the 1950s (!) it was common practice to receive what we called "Holy pictures" from parents, relatives, and teachers, to mark special occasions such as First Communion, birthdays, etc. I kept my collection, many of which I still have, in my Sunday missal. Most commonly they were depictions of Jesus, Mary, Joseph, and the saints. The pictures of Jesus often portrayed Him as standing tall, with long hair and beard and looking very meek and mild, presumably as a way of conveying his compassion and love. In today's Gospel, St John presents a very different representation of Jesus. The story of Jesus casting out the stall holders and the money changers from the temple portrays a very human Jesus who, rather than being meek and mild, is full of anger at what he has found. There are many layers of meaning to this story, but for me it highlights that fact that Jesus was fully human, like us in all things but sin. We catch brief glimpses of Jesus' humanity throughout the Gospels, and we can presume that he experienced the full gamut of human emotions, desires, and needs. Whilst he always proclaimed the love and mercy of God, wistfully portrayed in holy pictures, he also came to challenge and disturb the people of his time, especially the wealthy and powerful. Perhaps I also need to be challenged and disturbed during this Lenten season?
