GOSPEL REFLECTION: The Sowing of the Seed By Fr Michael Tate

A peasant in Galilee would hope for a return of 7:1 when sowing seed for a crop. So when Jesus pictures the Kingdom of God as a wonderful harvest (returning 100:1 as he put it in another parable), his peasant listeners would envisage a future without hunger, without servitude to rapacious landlords and money-lenders. A true liberation (such as Mary sang of in the Magnificat)!

Naturally, they and we want to know when this new way of life, this fulfilling of the Kingdom of God, will come about. Our Lord replies: 'Be patient. Your job is to sow the seed. Something will happen out of all proportion to your part in the process, just like the disproportion of the mustard seed to a mustard bush' (which he exaggerates into a tree sheltering birds).

God's creative power worked in the depths of stony ground of the tomb to raise up the Gospel Seed who is Jesus Christ. From that, a community has grown which, at its best, leads to a fair and just distribution of the world's resources, as Pope Francis insists is a major test of authenticity of our claim to be Christian.

We could take a moment to pray for the courage to sow the seed of the Gospel whenever an opportunity presents itself, and the patience to await the germinating power of the Resurrection to create the Tree of Life such that all peoples 'can shelter in its shade'.

REPORT FROM THE MEETING OF THE PARISH LEADERSHIP TEAM, 8th JUNE 2021. Mission Communities for the

Archdiocese of Melbourne: Parishioners are encouraged to read the Archbishop's Pentecost letter "Take the Way of the Gospel" which is available on our parish website. In the letter Archbishop Comensoli has outlined a vision of how our communities of faith are to be revitalised so that we may better proclaim the Good News to all people in our parishes and broader communities. The aim is for our parish communities to be effectively resourced spiritually, ministerially and materially into the future. It is proposed to establish Missions throughout the Archdiocese which may consist of individual parishes or groups of parishes so that gifts and resources may be shared and to ensure the sustainability of our missionary communities. Recently a meeting was held for all the priests of the Archdiocese and a separate meeting was held for a lay representative from each of the 209 parishes of the Archdiocese. Our parish was represented at that meeting by Chris Blake. Over the next twelve months meetings of parish representatives across the four regions of the Archdiocese will be held to start planning for the development of this exciting new stage in the life of the Church of Melbourne. Parishioners will be kept informed of these developments.
