Description: Newcastle disease, bronchitis vaccine (Mass. and Ark. type), killed virus, *Salmonella* Enteritidis bacterin

Directions For Use: Vaccine should be warmed to room temperature before use. Shake well before using. Inject subcutaneously or intramuscularly using aseptic technique. Use entire contents of bottle when first opened. Vaccinate (prime) with live virus vaccines for Newcastle disease and bronchitis at least 4 weeks prior to the use of this vaccine. Vaccinate subcutaneously at 12 and 16 weeks of age or intramuscularly at 13 and 17 weeks of age. Revaccinate with monovalent Salmonella Enteritidis bacterin 4 weeks later. Revaccinate during molt.

Dose: 1/4 ml (0.25 ml) per bird. Inject all birds in flock.

Recommended for the vaccination of chickens as an aid in the prevention of Newcastle disease and Infectious Bronchitis (Mass. and Ark. types) and as an aid to reduce the colonization of the internal organs, including the reproductive tract, by *Salmonella* Enteritidis.

Caution: Store at 2°-7°C (35°-45°F). Do not freeze.


