Directions for Use:

Bacterin should be warmed to room temperature before use. Shake well before using. Inject subcutaneously using aseptic technique. Use entire contents of bottle when first opened. Vaccinate chickens between 12 and 16 weeks of age. Revaccinate four weeks later. Revaccinate during molt.

Dose:

1/4 ml (0.25 ml) per bird. Inject all birds in flocks.

Follow directions carefully. As with any oil emulsion bacterin, improper vaccination technique may result in a reaction at the site of injection. Do not administer intramuscularly.

Strain Information:

Salmonella Enteritidis phage types 8, 14b, 23 and 24



Recommended for the vaccination of chickens as an aid in the reduction of Salmonella Enteritidis colonization of internal organs, including the reproductive tract.

Caution:

Store at 2°-8°C (35°-46°F). Do not freeze.

Warning:
