THE SERIES.

Taking place on prestigious world class golf courses, the aim of The R&A Student Tour Series is to provide elite amateur championships to enhance high performance competition amongst the leading student golfers outside of the USA and Mexico.

Players can earn Tour Series Order of Merit points by playing in qualifying events which take place in Sweden, Ireland, Portugal and Spain. The top 42 players (30 men and 12 women) from the Order of Merit after Portugal qualify for The R&A Student Tour Series Final in April 2026 over the Jubilee and Old Course in St Andrews.



ENTRY CRITERIA.

The Series shall be open to male and female players who have reached the age of 16 on 01 January 2025, but are no older than age 28 on 31 December 2026 provided that the entrant is a fully registered student and the holder of a student card for the university or educational institution with which they are internally registered. The following individuals shall be eligible to compete:

- i. A student who has been accepted and is due to enrol in the forthcoming academic semester, and commencing study not later than 31 October in the year of the Series;
- ii. A student satisfactorily finishing their course of study after 1 December 2025 will be eligible until the end of the academic year provided their institution still classifies them as a registered student. Satisfactorily finishing a course of study is not when a student graduates, but is deemed to be when their teaching, research and/or examinations are completed. Suspension of studies is not classed as satisfactorily finishing a course of study. Any student who has their studies suspended must wait until their studies recommence to compete again; and
- iii. A student embarking on a Sandwich Course and/or Study Abroad Course (e.g. Erasmus) is eligible during this time provided that: (a) the duration of the placement/course in industry and/or study abroad is 1 year or less; (b) if the duration is more than 1 year, then the student will be deemed ineligible after the passing of the 12-month mark.
- iv. A student who is either: (a) ranked within WAGR® listing 1 – 4000 (see wagr.com) at date of entry, or (b) hold a Handicap Index® of not more than +0.0 for men and 2.0 for women at date of entry, as issued by an Authorised Handicapping Body. In the absence of a Handicap Index® a current equivalent exact handicap, as issued by a recognised Handicap Authority.

Entrants holding both a WHS Handicap Index and a handicap issued by a recognised Handicap Authority, must enter Series events using their WHS Handicap Index. The penalty for failure to enter a Series event in compliance with this section is disqualification.

HOST VENUE.



2025 HOST VENUE HALMSTAD GOLF CLUB

Designed by Rafael Sundblom, Halmstad Golf Club in Tylosand was founded in 1930, it has hosted several major championships over the years. In 1985, the European Championships, in 2007 the Solheim Cup and in 2022 the Volvo Car Scandinavian Mixed.

The North Course is a real gem that a true golfer never tires of. Beautifully and carefully laid out it provides a natural experience while being a real test for any golfer. Each hole is its own room among tall pines with the wind from the nearby sea as a constant influencing factor.

Opening Hours – 24 hours a day

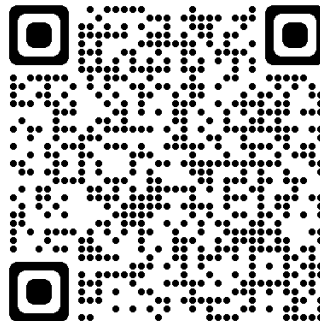
Players will have access to unlimited free of charge range balls for the duration of the championship (including practice day)

OFFICIAL HOTEL AND ACCOMMODATION.

Player accommodation has been reserved at Halmstad GOLFARENA approx. 5-7 min drive from Halmstad Golfclub. We have provisionally reserved the accommodation for you until 31 July.
