I think football is the best game in the world, and women's football is particularly brilliant.

More than 30 million girls and women play football around the world – it's the most popular women's team sport by a long way. And It's getting more and more popular every day.

The 2019 FIFA Women's World Cup smashed TV viewing records. The final between the USA and the Netherlands was the most watched women's football match of all time, with an incredible 263 million viewers around the world. Were you one of them? I was!

### A BOLD BEGINNING

In the 1890s, things weren't so great for women. They didn't have the same rights as men, and men thought they were better at everything. Women were supposed to be dignified. They weren't supposed to run around a football field getting muddy... but that's exactly what a group of British women wanted to do. This was the start of the women's game.

### Nettie Honeyball

As well as having the BEST NAME EVER, Nettie Honeyball formed the first British Ladies' Football Club in 1895.


The very first match was advertised in English newspapers.

#### Nettie said.

"There is no reason why football should not be played by women, and played well, too." Quite right, Nettie

Around 10,000 people came to watch Nettie's match. Some of the spectators cheered, but others shouted horrible things. Newspaper articles about the match mocked the women players, often commenting on how they looked. But this just made Nettie even more determined. She took women's football teams on a tour of England.





# Wartime

Strangely, the outbreak of World War I in 1914 helped women's football. Men's teams were disbanded, and women took over the men's jobs in the factories. Factory owners thought that it might be good for the workers to play football. They weren't doing it to be nice - they thought it would make the women work harder!


### **FOOTIE FACT**

A match in 1920 between Dick, Kerr Ladies and St Helens Ladies was attended by 53,000 people – that's about the same as an English Premier League match today! There were another 14,000 disappointed fans left outside the ground.

By 1920, Dick. Kerr Ladies was one of around 150 English women's tootball teams. But things were about to go very, very wrong...
