












THE COST OF KNOWING





I want you to picture a hero. Who are you imagining? Someone who can fly? Turn invisible? Lift a car off someone with just their little finger? Someone in an uncomfortable-looking costume and an expensive-looking car?

Most people don't think they're heroes. In fact, even after people do incredibly brave things, they'll often say something like: 'I'm not a hero, I'm just an ordinary human being'.

This made me wonder what it actually means to be a 'hero'. Can an ordinary human be a hero too? Could I ever be a hero? What about you?

Before I wrote the book you're holding now, I wrote about the lives of three hundred different people for a series of books about individuals who dared to be different. Each person was chosen

because they did, said, sang or made something that improved the lives of those around them. Some of them made discoveries among the stars, some put their lives on the line for peace, some raised money for those less fortunate than themselves and others spread joy through music, literature or art.

To me, each of those people were heroes. Why? Well, I would define 'hero' like this:



A HERO

is someone who WANTS TO LIVE

in a better world


and decides

TO DO SOMETHING about it.

That's the definition I believe to be true, at least. If you look 'hero' up in the dictionary, it might say something slightly different, but this isn't a dictionary, it's my book and I get to decide what it says. (It could say 'pizza is a vegetable' or 'headlice make good pets' if I wanted it to, though I'll try to keep things as close to the truth as possible.)

The cape-wearing superheroes in our films and comics still fit nicely into this definition: they want to make the world a better place and they all try to do something about it. Whether they were born

When I was around half the size I am now, I spent most nights secretly reading under my duvet by the light of my phone. I'd found a book called *Heroes of Polar Exploration* at a jumble sale. The book told the stories of people venturing to the coldest places on earth and, quite often, dying in them. These early explorers battled to survive in treacherous lands as they tried to gather scientific data on forces never before encountered by humans. Their toes froze and fell off, they starved, they started to see things that weren't there and many spent years lost in the icy wilderness. I was obsessed.

Soon, I was reading all I could about Antarctica and the Arctic. I spent my free time drawing maps. I planned expeditions across ice shelves and learned the different parts of a ship. When I read that Ernest Shackleton survived a polar winter by eating his dogs, I asked myself whether I too would eat my dog if I became an explorer. (I decided I wouldn't and that I'd just try and remember to bring enough cheese and onion crisps to last the whole journey.)

Take the case of Ellen MacArthur, who found herself reading an entirely different kind of book to Joanne or me. Ellen's book was an adventure story called *Swallows and Amazons*.





Of course, Joanne might not be the type of hero we see in films, but if leading an organisation that helps people in danger isn't heroic, then I'm not really sure what is.

Like me, Joanne found her dream between the covers of a book. But that's not the only place we can look for dreams. We can find them anywhere, which makes it important to look out for things that inspire us. Whenever I couldn't find something in my bedroom, my mum would say, 'It's not going to jump out and hit you in the face.' Unless I was looking for my sister, she was usually right. What also became clear was that the things I was looking for were never in the places I expected them to be. If they were, it wouldn't be so hard to find them.

Socks aren't hard to find when they're in the sock drawer. They're hard to find when they're in the fridge or the biscuit jar or the sweet tin that doesn't have sweets in it anymore, just old batteries and sticky coins.



They can leap out of books or films or songs or games you play with friends. They can arrive fully formed or they can grow slowly inside us, as we learn more and more about certain topics, places, people or events.

One friend of mine was ten years old when he went to the British Museum on a school trip and stumbled into the exhibit on Egyptians. He was instantly hooked. He's now an Egyptologist who spends a lot of time pottering around ancient tombs and trying to decipher messages that are over two thousand years old.

Another friend of mine was taken to the circus every year as a child but didn't take up juggling until he was thirty, after years spent being an accountant. Juggling was a dream that had been inside him since childhood, it just needed a little time to come out. And now he performs at festivals and fairs all over England. No one has to decide exactly what they want to do with their life while they're young.
