

Fresh from the Farm Healthy Fundraising for Ontario Schools

What is Fresh from the Farm?

Fresh from the Farm provides a healthy fundraising alternative to schools by selling fresh Ontario-grown fruit and vegetables. Since Fresh from the Farm's launch in 2013, 2,600 schools have sold over \$5.5 million of Ontario grown fruits and vegetables, equating to over 4.6 million pounds of product. This has resulted in \$2 million raised by schools and \$3.2 million being returned to local farmers.

Why Participate?

- Schools keep 40% of sales.
- Families enjoy fresh, Ontario-grown fruit and vegetables.
- Fresh from the Farm promotes a healthy school environment while providing an opportunity for students to raise money for school initiatives.
- Provides opportunities for students to learn about agri-food and healthy eating
- Supports Ontario farmers and our local economy

What are the Ontario-grown bundle options for sale?

Vegetable Bundle: \$22.00

Includes

5 lb bag white potatoes
3 lb bag sweet potatoes
3 lb bag yellow onions
3 lb bag orange carrots

Apple Bundle: \$24.00

NEW - 8 lb bag Ambrosia apples

Ambrosia's are a beautiful bright pinkish red and light yellow coloured apple. They are crisp and juicy with a distinct sweet aroma and sweet low acid flavour. Excellent for eating fresh.

How does it Work?

- Schools enrol on <u>www.freshfromfarm.ca</u> by <u>September 30</u>
- Fundraise by selling Ontario grown Vegetable and Apple bundles to family, friends and the school community. Encourage buy one and donate one to a local community organization.
- School Champion must submit orders online by October 17
- School Champions will receive a 10 day advance delivery notice with specific date and 3 hour delivery window of when your product will arrive to your school.
- Deliveries take place between November 4 and December 5
- On the delivery day, volunteers receive product and package Vegetable bundles into
 Fresh from the Farm bags provided. Apple bundles arrive pre-packaged in separate bags.

Instructions to Fundraisers:

- Record customer orders, collect payment of schools choice, complete the customer information on the Student Order Form
- Return the Order Form and payments to the school by the date advised by your School Champion.
