New Footpath and Kerb Ramps - Winchester Road, Little Mountain

Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to increasing and maintaining pathway networks across our region.

Construction will begin on a new footpath along the western side of Winchester Road, Little Mountain.

The new 1.8m-wide path will connect the existing footpath from Winchester Road to Woodroffe Street. Kerb ramps are also being installed across Winchester Road to allow for easier crossing and future connectivity.

Start date

Works are expected to commence Monday 2 October 2023 and be finished within a week, weather and site conditions permitting.

Property access and parking

Property access should not be affected during works. However, if the contractor does require access, then property owners will be notified in advance.

On-street parking along Winchester Road may be limited at times for the safety of pedestrians, road users and contractors.
