Construction Update

Sunshine Coast Council will soon begin construction to replace the ageing revetment wall at Bradman Avenue (Cod Hole) boat ramp and upgrade the adjoining car park. Refer to **figure 1** for the location of works.

Construction of the car park requires some vegetation removal in the tidal zone. All relevant approvals have been obtained.

Program and Timing

Works are scheduled to commence in February 2023 with completion expected in May 2023, site and weather conditions permitting.

The revetment wall will be rebuilt first, followed by car park resurfacing and new line marking.

Changes to traffic conditions

The Cod Hole boat ramp and entire car park will be closed for the duration of works for public safety. Alternative boat ramp locations are shown on **figure 2**.

We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause. The public toilets will remain open for use.

Council will be doing everything possible to ensure this project is completed on time and with minimal inconvenience to the public. Your patience during construction is appreciated.
