# Parking Bay and Drainage Construction – Croydon Avenue Currimundi

## **Project summary**

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to increasing access to community venues across our region.

Works will begin soon on the installation of a tencar parking bay on Croydon Avenue, adjacent to Grahame Stewart Park in Currimundi. The outcome will be improved parking during peak periods for both residents and the community. For the exact location please see figure 1 overleaf.

Works also include upgrading the current street drainage.

No trees will be removed for the works.

#### Start date

Work is scheduled to start the week beginning Monday 13 March 2023.

Construction is expected to be completed within three weeks, weather and site conditions permitting.

# Property access and parking

During construction, property access and onstreet parking will be affected for short durations. Council officers will fence off areas and, in some instances, contact residents to discuss timing for access or parking.

## **Traffic management**

Traffic management measures will be in place throughout construction to ensure the safety of all road users. Temporary road closures will be required during drainage construction.
