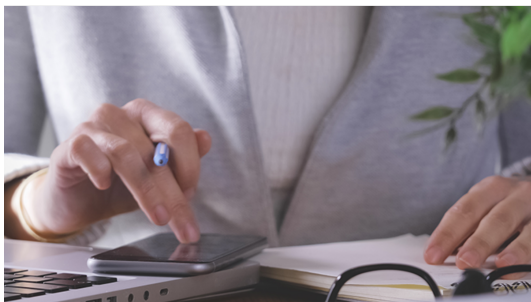
Ruminate by Paula Bowie
