## Footpath Renewal – Caloundra Esplanade, Caloundra

### Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to increasing and maintaining pathway networks across our region.

Construction will begin soon on renewing and widening the existing footpath to 1.8 metres wide along the Northern side of Caloundra Esplanade from Minchinton Street to Knox Avenue, Caloundra.

A total length of 197 metres of path will be renewed. Ramps to the road will also be renewed.

### Start date

This project is scheduled to start on Wednesday 4 October 2023 and will be finished within two weeks, weather and site conditions permitting.

### Property access

Construction crews will contact residents prior to starting any works which may affect property access.

### Traffic management

Traffic management measures will be in place throughout construction to ensure the safety of all road users.
