Sunshine Coast Council will be improving connectivity with a new footpath along the worn track at Caralan Way Park, Beerwah.

The new footpath will span approximately 180 metres from Emma Place along the existing dirt pathway alignment.

No trees will be removed or impacted for this new footpath.
