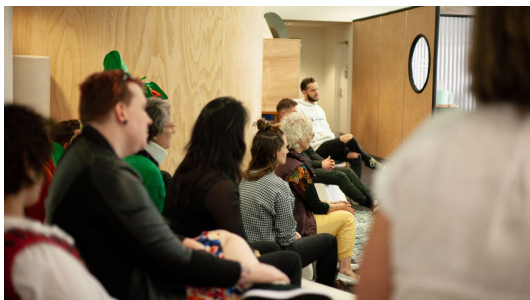
NAIDOC: Get Up! Stand Up! Show Up!

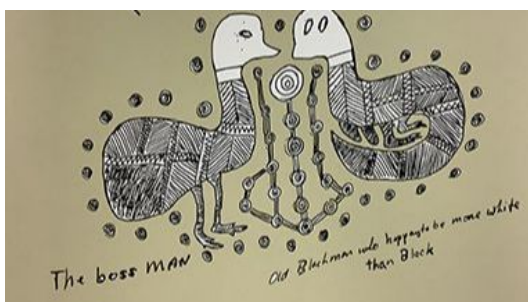

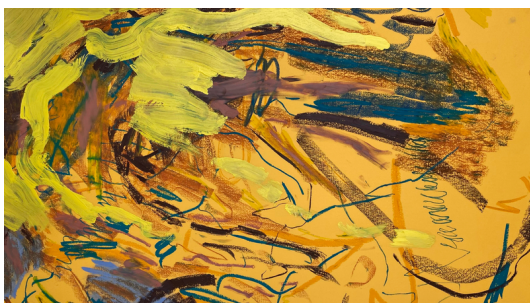
