# Tree Planting - Caloundra Road, Caloundra West

### Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is about to commence work to improve the environment and help beautify the Caloundra Road corridor.

The Caloundra Road Tree Planting project will provide feature accents, colour and visual interest to this major thoroughfare that is the gateway to Caloundra. The project involves infill street tree planting at selected sites between Kawana Way Link Road and Nicklin Way on Caloundra Road.

The planting sites have been selected to either strengthen existing vegetation areas or to soften and improve the visual amenity of the streetscape.

Tree species have been carefully chosen to complement the sites and follow the local street tree strategies outlined in councils Street Tree Master Plan.

The species that will be planted under powerlines within the high-density area of Caloundra Road will be large shrubs/small trees to provide splashes of colour and interest.

Larger species are proposed in areas where space permits.

### Start date

Work is scheduled to commence November 2022 and construction is expected to last for two weeks (weather dependent). Work hours will be 6:30am – 5:00pm, Monday to Friday.

### Property access and parking

Contractors will barrier off the immediate area each day for the duration of the planting to maintain public safety.

Footpaths around the work sites will remain open to the public during construction.

### Traffic management

During the planting, traffic management measures will be in place to ensure safety of pedestrians, workers and motorists.

Your patience and cooperation during construction is appreciated.










## Caloundra Road Tree Planting Plan
