It's the first of the month which means our September artists in residence are bumping in. This month we have Orlando Mee from South Australia with support by Country Arts South Australia (CASA). Orlando is a multimedia artist working on Narungga land in Wallaroo. He makes video art, projection art, web-based works, VR and interactive experiences. In the Makers Space we have Libby Derham. Watercolour runs in Libby's veins, going back four generations in her family. Currently working in Cymatics with Joseph Burgess, Libby is exploring the relationship between watercolour and the visualisation of birdsong through liquid. 




