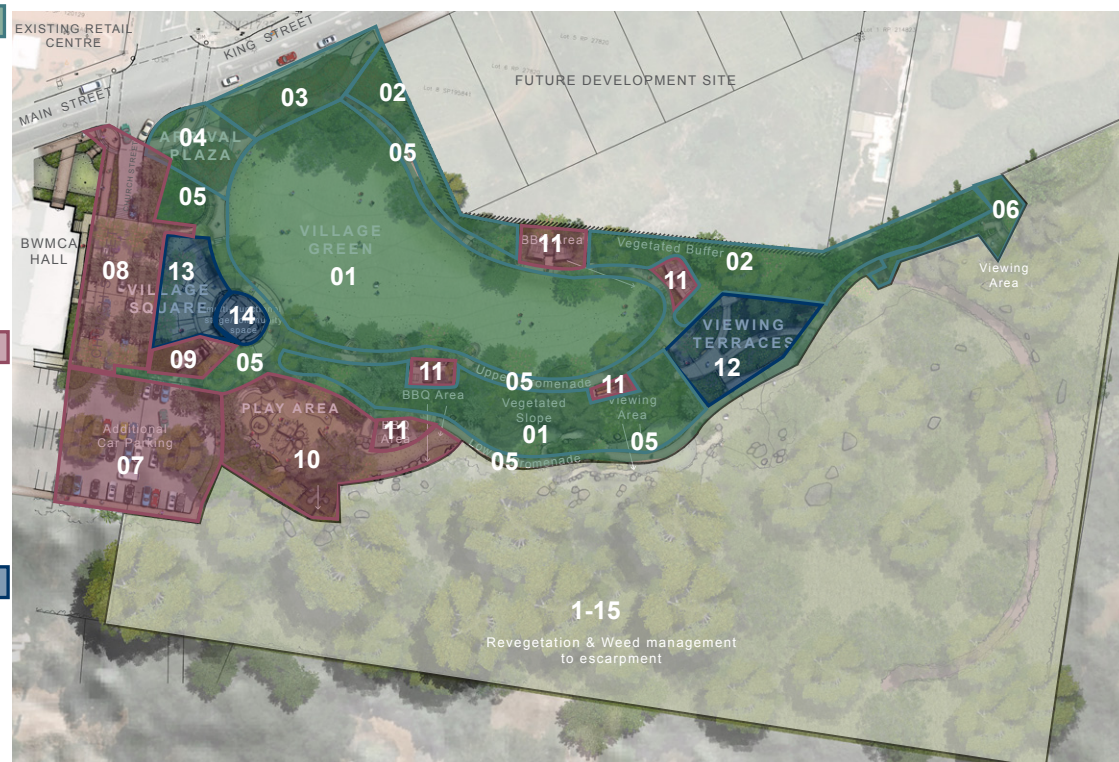

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## Buderim's new district-level recreation park

### Community engagement

In August 2011, Buderim residents and the wider community were invited to comment on the draft Landscape Concept Plan for Buderim District Park, corner of Church and King Streets, Buderim.

Comments and support for the proposal included:

*"Love the concept plans, please keep as much open space as possible and some views, lots of trees and it looks like you have the rest covered."*

*"This concept plan encapsulates the essence of the site, the viewing experience whilst integrating cultural and passive recreation experiences for a very wide range of people, visitors and residents alike."*

Suggestions put forward by the community included (but not limited to):

- possible options for the new park's name
- recommendations for the park's planting palette
- Church Street parking and the number of proposed new parking bays
- location of park infrastructure, e.g. bbqs
- the provision of art opportunities and lighting
- reflect Buderim's character and style through the landscape and architectural elements.

### Landscape concept plan

Council carefully evaluated the feedback and is pleased to present the final Landscape Concept Plan for your information.

The park design aims to convey and encapsulate the visionary themes and ideas that emerged from the consultation process.

Council would like to thank those who participated in the development of the vision and design for the new park.

### Stage one construction

Council has allocated funding in the 2011-2012 financial year for design development and construction of stage one.

Construction of stage one works is scheduled to commence in June 2012 and will take place over a period of ten weeks (weather dependent).

### Where to from here

The development of the new district-level park will occur in a number of stages over several years. The rate and extent of implementation is subject to the availability of future funding.
