Stormwater Pit Upgrade – Lumeah Drive, Mount Coolum

Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to maintaining our infrastructure across the region.

As part of this year's stormwater renewal program, council is replacing one stormwater pit on Lumeah Drive, Mount Coolum.

Start date

Work is scheduled to start the week beginning Monday 18 September 2023. Construction is expected to be completed within one week, weather and site conditions permitting.

Work will occur between 7am and 5pm on weekdays.

Property access and parking

During works, access to properties will be maintained, however there will be a temporary loss to on-street parking to facilitate construction.

Traffic management

To ensure the safety of all road users, traffic management measures will be in place throughout the project, including temporary construction fencing and staffed traffic control.
