What happened:	Regular inspections in collaboration with Council identified the trail as being in need of upgrading involving erosion damage repair, heavy use maintenance and erosion mitigation works. The trail upgrades involved CORCA, a professional trail building contractor and volunteers working together. This included using a small machine to dig multiple drains, and around 10 volunteers using wheel barrows to import decomposed granite to bolster all wet areas, harden the trail surface in high wear areas and to fill trail wear points.
