GRAVEL ROAD UPGRADE: PERRINS ROAD, EUDLO - STAGE 2

Project summary

Work will soon commence on the unsealed section of Perrins Rd approximately 1km from the intersection of Logwoods Rd. Works will include widening, sealing and the construction of retaining structures. Unfortunately, some trees will need to be removed to construct the roadworks and maintain safe sight lines. A fauna spotter-catcher will be on-site to monitor clearing. All tree clearing will be offset by planting at one of Council's environmental reserves at a ratio of 4:1.

Start date

Works are currently scheduled to start Monday, 28 August 2023 and be completed by Friday, 24 November. Weather and site conditions permitting.

Property access and parking

We plan to maintain driveway access throughout the works, however there will be some disruption when we seal the road and driveway entrances. Council's construction workers will advise impacted residents regarding the timing of these works.

Traffic management

All efforts will be made to keep at least one lane of the road open to through traffic throughout the works. However, it may be necessary to close the road to through traffic from time to time. In these circumstances variable message boards will advise motorists in advance of closure times. Residents within the works area will always be provided access but may be subject to minor delays.

Figure 1: Locality Plan

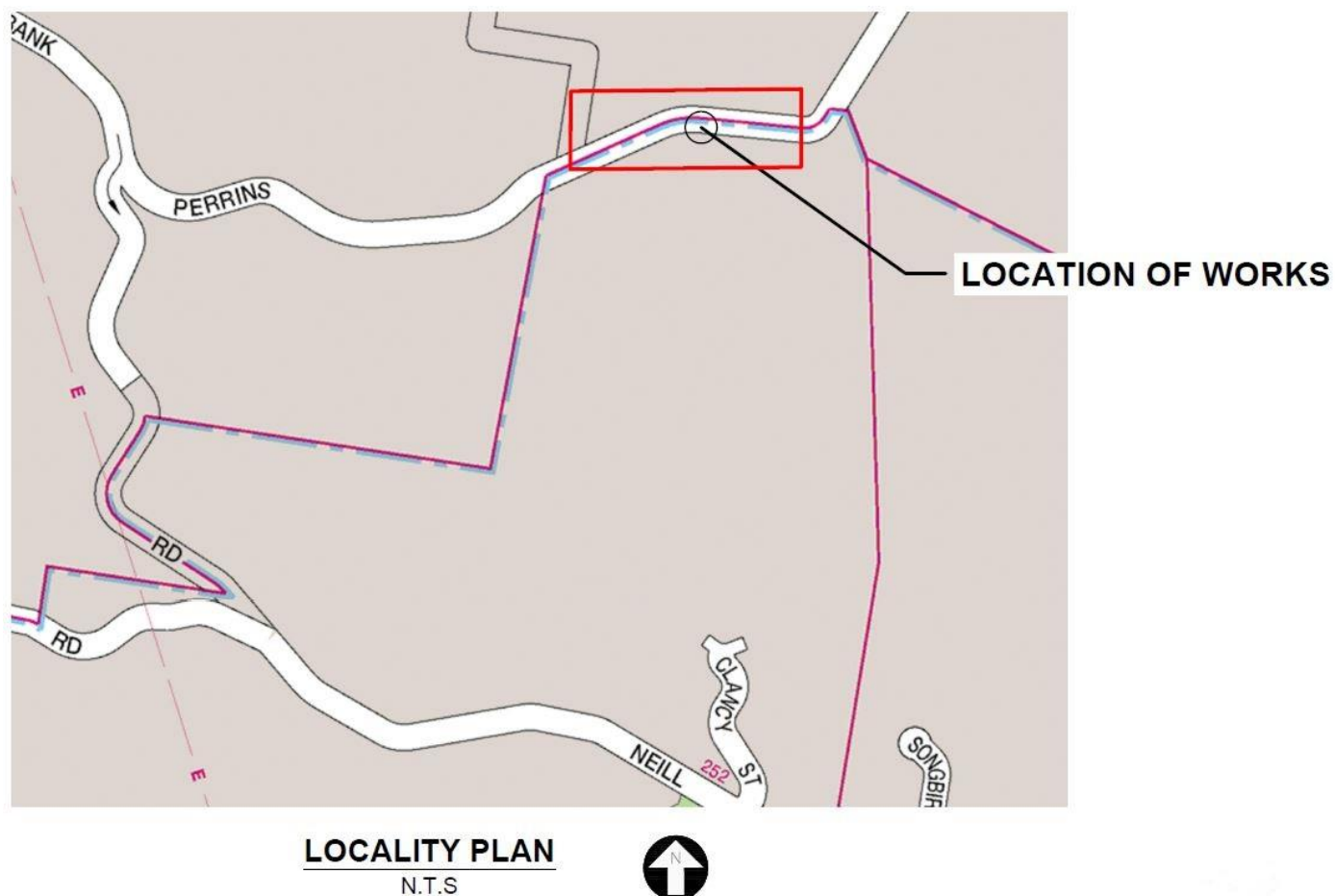


Figure 1: General Layout
