This month at 2nd Space we're welcoming Nicole Voevodin-Cash and Jaime Kiss as our artists in residence. [Nicole Voevodin-Cash](#) is a mixed method artist encompassing land art, public art, installation, performance, film, digital technologies, and sculpture. For this residency, Nicole is experimenting with the idea of 'what is inflatable', where air gives life to something inanimate, the human form can further

enhance, grow and metabolise the structures that it connects to. [Jaime Kiss's](#) works provoke questions of how we perceive ourselves and the world around us to interpret reality. In his recent work, Jaime has created a series of digital paintings and collages, exploring ideas related to the continuation, cycles, changes and transformations, playing with the interaction created between the medium and spectators.

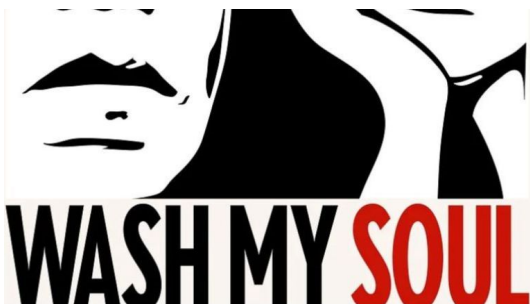


2022 Sunshine Coast Art Prize

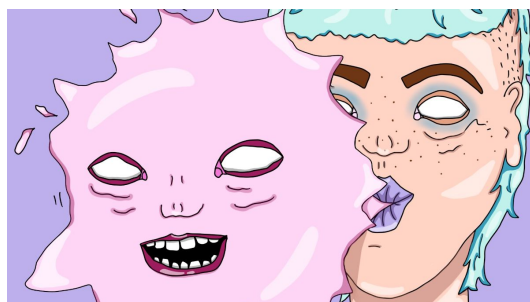
