Stormwater Pit Upgrade - Bringenbrong Drive, Buderim

Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to maintaining our infrastructure across our region.

As part of this year's stormwater renewal program, council is replacing a stormwater inlet headwall on Bringenbrong Drive, Buderim. Please refer to figure 1 overleaf.

A headwall is a small retaining wall built at the basin of a storm water drainage pipe.

The renewal is required to reduce any erosion to the pipe, and surrounding area, caused by the constant flow of water.

Start date

Work is scheduled to start the week beginning Monday 6 March 2023. Construction is expected to be completed within two weeks, weather and site conditions permitting.

Work will occur between 7am and 5pm on weekdays.

Property access and parking

During works, access to properties will be maintained, however there will be a temporary loss to on-street parking to facilitate construction.

Traffic management

To ensure the safety of all road users, traffic management measures will be in place throughout the project, including temporary construction fencing and staffed traffic control.
