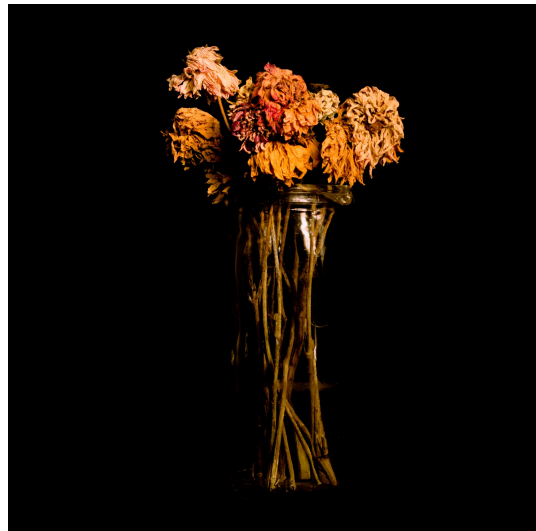
**Regional Arts Development Fund
