Upgrading to a new version of Kentico

Things You Will Need

- A local copy of the site's files
- A local copy of the site's database
- Kentico license(s):

For your local environment, each version of Kentico from the current version to the target version

For the live domain, the target version of Kentico

Initial Preparation

Make a copy of the site files and database and use them to check that the site builds in Visual studio with no errors.





Errors in Visual Studio when trying to build the site.

Must troubleshoot and resolve before you can move on.

Remove Unused Code

If you have any code, data or custom functionality on your site that is not actively used, remove it to speed up the upgrade process.

Run the Kentico Upgrade Tool

Put your site into "deployment mode." Download the Kentico Upgrade tool for your current version of Kentico and run it from the command line using the "automatic conversion" option.



Large databases and slow connections can cause change scripts to timeout. Run manually within SQL.





Perform the Upgrade

Make a backup of the site files and database and run the Kentico Upgrade Utility. Be sure to upgrade both project files and database.

Update Custom Code

Enable deployment mode. Copy upgraded files from the Code
Upgrade Tool into your project then review the provided
spreadsheet of recommended changes and make any additional
manual changes for custom code and rebuild the site.





API changes are a frequent culprit.

Not able to build the site in Visual Studio after updating.



Final Testing Take the site back out

Take the site back out of deployment mode, re-sign all macros, and add new Kentico licenses. Test to make sure your site is working as expected.
