Tutor/mentor

Student Ombudsman

Gives you information about relevant regulations and procedures and informs you of your rights, obligations and options with a view to solving the problem you are facing.

Confidential counsellor on academic integrity

Advises you in relation to suspected violations of the Code of Conduct for Academic Integrity.
