

VU Reading Lists

A short guide for students



Teachers can use VU Reading Lists to provide students the course readings via Canvas. Lists can be found in modules or via the application in de side-menu.

As a student you can quickly access the literature, check the library availability and manage your readings. It makes it easier to find, and use the right literature in your course. This is what it looks like in Canvas.
