




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

Dr Sylvia van de Bunt, Associate Professor, Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam, Visiting Professor, University of Suffolk

In 1965, Rev Martin Luther King Jr received an honorary doctorate from the Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam honouring his service in the fight for social justice and human rights. King's approach, exemplifying the servant-leadership style is more relevant than ever before.

In this seminar, Dr van de Bunt will explore modern crises in a historical perspective through the eyes of dr. King: the covid-pandemic, global warming, human rights, and institutional racism.
