

Regulations Multifaith space (HG 1A-53) Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam

Purpose

The quiet room is used for activities of a philosophical nature. Think of meditation and moments of silence or prayer and deepening moments. As a rule Islamic prayer meetings do not take place in the quiet room. The Islamic prayer room is in HG 1A-57.

Access

The silence room is open to students, staff and guests of Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam. The room is located on the second floor of the Main Building.

Use

- The silence room is intended for activities of a philosophical nature. It is not a relaxation room, not a discussion room, nor a study room.
- Meetings that meet the description above may also be offered in conjunction with NEWConnective.
- The quiet room should be cleaned up after use. Religious symbols, writings, etc. should be stored in the closet, in order to guarantee the open character of the Space preserve the open character of the Room.
- No eating or drinking is allowed in the space.
- The space is not intended as a storage area. You cannot leave personal belongings here.

Agenda and maintenance

The quiet room is managed by the NEWConnective team. Corporate Real Estate and Facilities (FCO) provides maintenance and cleaning.
